Meetings are held monthly except in January, July and August. Speakers are featured at most meetings. Everyone is welcome. Check *KINDLING* for dates.

Members receive our *KINDLING* Newsletter four times a year (Spring, Summer, Fall, and Winter) and may submit free queries. Non-member fee is \$1.00 per query. All are invited to offer articles and notes for publication.

The Darke County Research & Genealogy Library is open to the public. Volunteers help visitors with dozens of drawers and shelves of surname files, and local and regional family histories. Two computers are available for research use and the library subscribes to Ancestry.com. Family record donations are always welcome. Exhibits at Garst Museum feature such Darke County notables as U.S. Navy Cdmr Zachary Lansdowne, Annie Oakley, Lowell Thomas and others. In 1985 the house in which Thomas was born was relocated from northern Darke County to the museum grounds, and is available for tours in the summer.

Museum entrance is through the front door of the Garst House. Handicap ramp entrance is located at parking spaces in front of the Lowell Thomas wing.

Pioneer Families

Any member of the DCGS, a chapter of the Ohio Genealogical Society, who is a direct descendant of an individual who settled in the area currently or once defined as Darke County by 31 December 1830, may become a member of *Pioneer Families of Darke County*, upon acceptance of membership and dues, and acceptance of *application and fee, with proof of such descent.

First Families

Any member of the DCGS, a chapter of the Ohio Genealogical Society, who is a direct descendant of an individual who settled in the area currently or once defined as Darke County by 31 December 1850, may become a member of the *First Families of Darke County*, upon acceptance of membership and dues, and acceptance of *application and fee with proof of such descent.

Civil War Ancestor(s)

Any member of the DCGS, a chapter of the Ohio Genealogical Society, who is a direct descendant of an individual who served from Darke County in the Civil War (1861-1865, proof of service required, may become a member of *Civil War Ancestors of Darke County*, upon acceptance of membership and dues, and acceptance of *application and fee, with proof of such descent.

Specification For Lineage continued

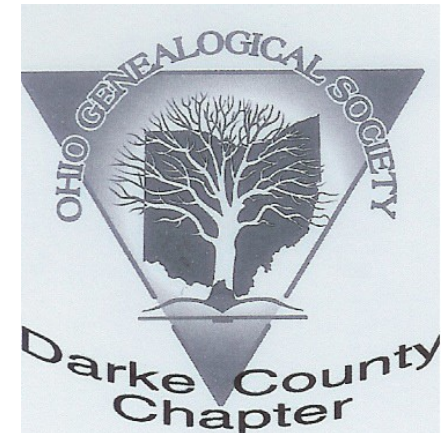
Century Ancestor(s)

Any member of the DCGS, a chapter of the Ohio Genealogical Society, who is a direct descendant of an individual who was in Darke County, from 01 January 1851 to present date minus 100 years, may become a member of *Century Ancestors of Darke County*, upon acceptance of membership and dues, and acceptance of *application and fee with proof of such descent.
